Rehearsal and Performance Schedule - 2018

Disney's FREAKY FRIDAY

Rehearsals start Tues July 3; 8 Perf. Wed-Sun July 11-July 15 (2 shows on Thurs, Sat, & Sun). There will be several kids involved in the show, and we are especially looking for one 9-12 year old boy to play the role of 10-year-old Fletcher, who delights in using puppets to annoy his 16-year-old sister Ellie. Actor must sing nicely and have a good sense of humor. Director is Wayne Bryan, Choreographer is Brian J. Marcum, and Thomas W. Douglas is Musical Director.

PIPPIN

Rehearsals start Thursday July 12; 7 Perf. Wed-Sun July 25-29 (2 shows on Sat & Sun). The show requires one boy (age 9-12) to play Theo, a scrappy young peasant, who sings and moves well, and can handle comic dialogue. Dance or acrobatic skills will also be especially helpful. Same actor also plays young Prince Pippin in the prologue. Show will be staged by Al Blackstone and Wayne Bryan, with Thomas W. Douglas as Musical Director.

Disney's THE LITTLE MERMAID

Rehearsals start Tues July 31; 10 Perf. Wed-Sun August 8-18 (2 shows on Sat & Sun) and Fri-Sat August 17-18 (1 show on Friday & 2 shows on Saturday).

We will be using a good number of Teens and Kids as singing-dancing sea creatures, featured in "Under the Sea" and "Kiss the Girl." We also need one 9-12 year old pop-singing actor (could be girl or boy) to play Ariel's companion Flounder, who leads the song "She's in Love." Director-choreographer is Linda Goodrich, with Thomas W. Douglas as Musical Director.
