JOB TITLE: Master Carpenter

JOB TYPE: Seasonal, Salaried

SUPERVISES: Scene Shop Carpenters, Scene Shop Intern

GENERAL JOB STATEMENT: Build and installation of scenery for assigned shows using a variety of methods and materials. Must work well with a team of scenic craftspeople to create excellent work in a timely manner. Must be able to work independently on specialty projects while simultaneously providing leadership and direction to other carpenters in the scene shop.

PRINCIPLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Build scenery as directed by TD, ATD, and/or Shop Foreman
- Perform repairs to scenery as directed.
- Load-in and Strike scenery safely.
- Maintain clean and safe working environment.
- Complete projects on schedule with a high level of quality.
- Provide direction and leadership to other shop carpenters and interns.
- Work closely with Shop Foreman to delegate assignment and establish priorities.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS:

- Minimum 4 years in theatrical carpentry.
- Ability to read and interpret working drawings.
- Knowledge of standard and safe rigging practices.
- Knowledge and ability in a variety of scenic construction methods.
- Proficiency in theatrical construction techniques.
