## **Properties Master – Job Description**



JOB TITLE: Properties Master ALTERNATE TITLES: Props Master, Prop Shop Coordinator, Prop Shop Manager REPORTS TO: Production Manager JOB TYPE: Seasonal, Salaried SUPERVISES: Props Artisans, Props Carpenter, Production Propsperson, Props Intern

**GENERAL JOB STATEMENT:** Working with the scenic designer and assistant props master, plan and execute the construction, painting, and/or finishing of various props as required of each show. This person should be familiar with and be comfortable supervising a variety of construction techniques and materials including: woodworking, metalworking, sewing, painting, and crafts. The Props Master is also responsible for the supervision and administration of the season's properties budget.

## PRINCIPLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Collaborate with the Director, Scenic Designer, and Stage Management on the creation / pulling of properties and set dressing for current and upcoming shows.
- Ability to read, interpret, estimate, and build from designer drawings, sketches, photos, video, etc.
- Estimate material and labor needs based on the script, director's needs, designer models and drafting, and meetings.
- Manage props budgets and ensure timely and accurate review of all budget reports.
- Attend design and production meetings and technical/dress rehearsals.
- Coordinate with the Director, Scenic Designer, and Stage Manager in creating and updating the master show props listing.
- Supervise the assembly and sourcing of any necessary rehearsal props and deliver to rehearsal space.
- Assist in load-in and strike of all prop elements.
- Collaborate with all other shops.
- Ensure sufficient stock of all shop materials and consumables.
- Participate/supervise in props/scenic transfers to and from warehouses, theatres, and rehearsal halls as needed.
- Supervise the touch up, repair, and maintenance of items once show is open.
- Work in a safe, efficient, and organized manner.
- Any other tasks as requested by the Production Manager.

## QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS:

- Minimum Bachelor's Degree in Technical Theatre or related field / equivalent experience.
- Minimum 3 years' experience in properties.
- Ideal candidate will have a range of props artisan skills including, but not limited to; cabinetry, scene
  painting, hand and machine stitching, soft good construction, upholstery, mold making and casting, floral
  arranging, paper goods graphics and construction, fine carpentry woodworking and furniture
  construction, MIG welding, and scenery carpentry.
- Strong organizational skills.
- Positive attitude, excellent communication skills, and the ability to work in a collaborative manner.
