GENERAL JOB STATEMENT: The Electrician Spotlight Operator works with a crew of other electricians under the supervision of the Head of Electrics to safely complete the installation and focus of the lighting plot in addition to any set electrics, atmospherics, or minor special effects. They will also operate the spotlights during tech and performances.

PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Safely install and focus all lighting equipment as needed.
- Ability to read and interpret a lighting plot.
- Maintain and repair lighting instruments and equipment.
- Operate spotlights for tech and performances under the directive of the Lighting Designer, Assistant Lighting Designer and Stage Management.
- Participate in all show load-ins and load-outs.
- Assist in organization and maintenance of workspaces and tools.
- Ability to work as a member of a crew.
- Any additional tasks as requested by the Head of Electrics or Director of Production
